



Alberta Donkey and Mule Club Competitive Point System

- High Point Riding
- High Point Driving
- High Point In-Hand
- High Point Youth
- High Point Education

Rules:

- 1) Member must be current and in good standing with the Alberta Donkey and Mule Club
- 2) Members can only earn points with Long Ears, not horses
- 3) Fee is \$15.00 per year
- 4) Points will be awarded to one handler/rider/driver for Junior, Senior or Open classes.
- 5) Points can only be accepted from those events taking place after the application and fee have been received by the Association office. Annual remittance of application and fee is required before points may be accumulated for that year
- 6) Members can earn points with Long Ears as young as weanlings
- 7) Members collecting points are responsible for submitting their own reports for each event signed by the organizer where applicable. Deliberate attempts to receive unwarranted points may result in suspension of the member
- 8) Event reports may be forwarded at any time of the year to the association office; however, reports must be submitted within 30 days of the event to be counted
- 9) All submissions must be received by the association by December 31st of the same calendar year in order to be valid
- 10) Winners will be announced by January 31st the following year, recognized at our Annual Meeting
- 11) In any class, points shall be awarded on the basis of the total number of equines actually judged in each class, whether or not an elimination is held
- 12) ADMC Executive has authority to whether an event qualifies- when in doubt please ask!
- 13) The following events will qualify for points:
 - Clinic (minimum 2.5 hours)
 - Equine Shows/Competitions (all disciplines welcome and encouraged)

14) Points at equine shows and competitions will be determined as follows:
